- 24/7 reading room and library with braille books, e-books, audio books.

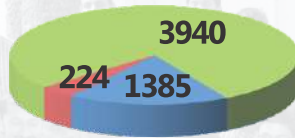

Number of Students in our Residential and Online training (till 2022)

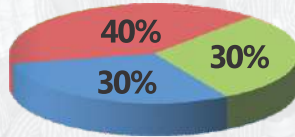

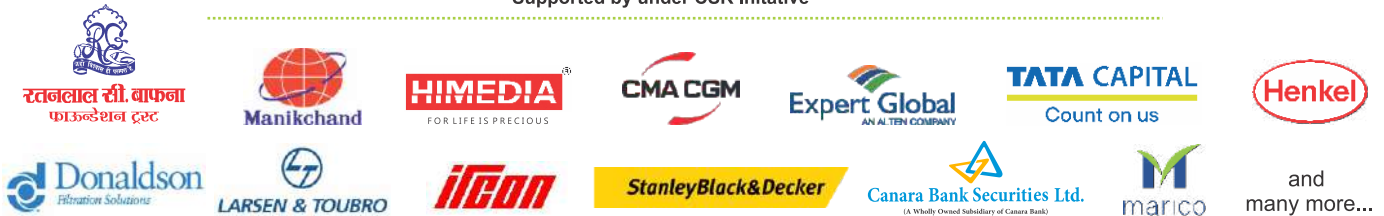
Construction of Manobal's New Campus
