TECHNOLOGY FOR ALL: A SHARED VISION

- Mr. Prashant Deshpande, Founder and former Managing Director of Expert Global Group (Expert Global Solutions Pvt. Ltd., an Alten company), and Dr. Renu John, Professor and Head of the Department of Biomedical Engineering at IIT Hyderabad and Co-Director at the Center for Healthcare Entrepreneurship, visited Deepstambh Manobal.
- During their visit, they engaged in in-depth discussions with students and staff on how innovative technologies can further empower persons with disabilities. They explored Manobal's key training facilities, including the Learning Lab,

ACCESSIBILITY AWARENESS WEEK

- As part of Global Accessibility Awareness Week, Manobal welcomed alumni and Chevening Scholar Ms. Diksha Dinde for a heartfelt interaction with students with disabilities. She spoke about the essence and significance of accessibility, sharing insights from her academic journey and comparing the accessibility landscape in India and abroad.
- Reflecting this year's theme, "Commitment to Change," a powerful session titled "Moving Towards Self-Reliance Through Technology" was led by our visually impaired technology trainer, Mr. Faiyaz. He introduced students to a range of AI tools and assistive technologies. We also highlighted global trends in assistive technology and how the Manobal project is purposefully designed to meet the diverse needs of all its students in an inclusive and empowering manner.
- Students with various disabilities shared their personal experiences and perspectives on accessibility at Manobal, adding meaningful reflections to the week-long celebration and reinforcing the importance of inclusion through awareness and action.



MANOBAL STUDENTS SHINE IN UPSC, MPSC, AND BMC EXAMS

- 18 students, including 7 persons with disabilities, successfully cleared the UPSC Civil Services Examination 2024. Among them, Manu Garg, a visually impaired student, secured All India Rank 1 in the VI category.
- Additionally, More than 50 students from Deepstambh Foundation's Manobal Project comprising individuals with disabilities, orphans, and those from economically weaker sections cleared the MPSC Group C (Revenue Assistant) and BMC (Executive Assistant) exams.
- Their success, achieved by overcoming social and personal barriers, reflects the resilience and determination that Manobal instills in each student.
- Empowering every child through inclusive education, equal opportunity, and the strength to serve the nation with integrity – that's the Manobal mission.

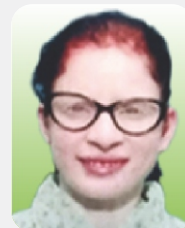

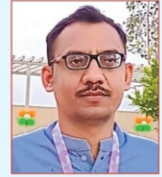

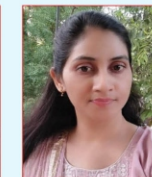

SPARKING LIGHT FROM DARKNESS: MANU GARG'S INSPIRING JOURNEY



- Manu Garg is from Jaipur. He lost his eyesight in the ninth grade. While many might have seen this as the end of a promising academic path, for Manu, it marked the beginning of an extraordinary journey. Fueled by determination and the unwavering support of his mother, a devoted teacher and single parent he found strength in adversity. She became his guiding light, reading every lesson aloud and instilling in him the courage to dream beyond limitations.
- Today, Manu has turned that dream into reality. He holds an All India Rank of 91 in UPSC 2024 and Rank 1 in the Visually Impaired category.
- Reflecting on his journey, he shared: "I have been associated with the Deepstambh Foundation Manobal Project and Manobal is the definitive empowerment centre for persons with disabilities providing accessible resources, expert mentoring, and a nurturing environment that turns every obstacle into opportunity."

RISING BEYOND ODDS: YOGESH'S INSPIRING PATH

- Yogesh Patil, a Gold Medalist in Economics and an alumnus of the 2022–2024 batch of Deepstambh Foundation, has carved a remarkable journey from humble beginnings to becoming a Government officer. Currently serving as a Talathi in Jalgaon District of Maharashtra.
- Yogesh was recently appointed as a member of the Economics Board of Study at Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University. "Deepstambh is my family. The values I learned here helped me achieve my dream," Yogesh shared.
