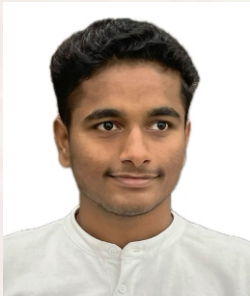
EMPOWERING YOUNG MINDS: STUDENT GUIDANCE SESSION AT KALYAN
