- Ravi Raj, a visually impaired alumnus from Bihar, shared insights on note-making and preparation strategies tailored for students with disabilities. “Patience and consistency helped me succeed in my fourth attempt,” he shared. “Accessible study material is vital, and Manobal plays a critical role in ensuring this.”

- Archit Dongre, who secured All India Rank 3, echoed similar sentiments: “When your ‘why’ is clear, the ‘how’ finds its way. Believe in yourself, be consistent, and don’t let challenges define your path.” He praised Manobal’s inclusive learning environment and emphasized its importance in shaping empowered futures.



NATIONAL WORKSHOP FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED TEACHERS – LUCKNOW

A three-day capacity-building workshop was recently held in Lucknow, bringing together 90 visually impaired teachers from Kendriya Vidyalayas across India. The program was thoughtfully organized by Mr. Kaushal and Mr. Raj from Kanpur.

- Born with a physical disability in a small village to farmer parents, Vinod Maharanvar's journey began amidst hardship and low expectations. Walking two kilometers daily for school, he nurtured quiet dreams against harsh realities.
- His turning point came with Deepstambh Manobal. "I realized I wasn't alone—there were others like me, fighting and moving forward," he shares. At Manobal, he found guidance, strength, and a renewed sense of purpose.
- Clearing the MPSC exam, Vinod now serves as a Revenue Assistant at the Mumbai High Court. His story is a testament to resilience, and a reminder that with the right support, no dream is beyond reach.
