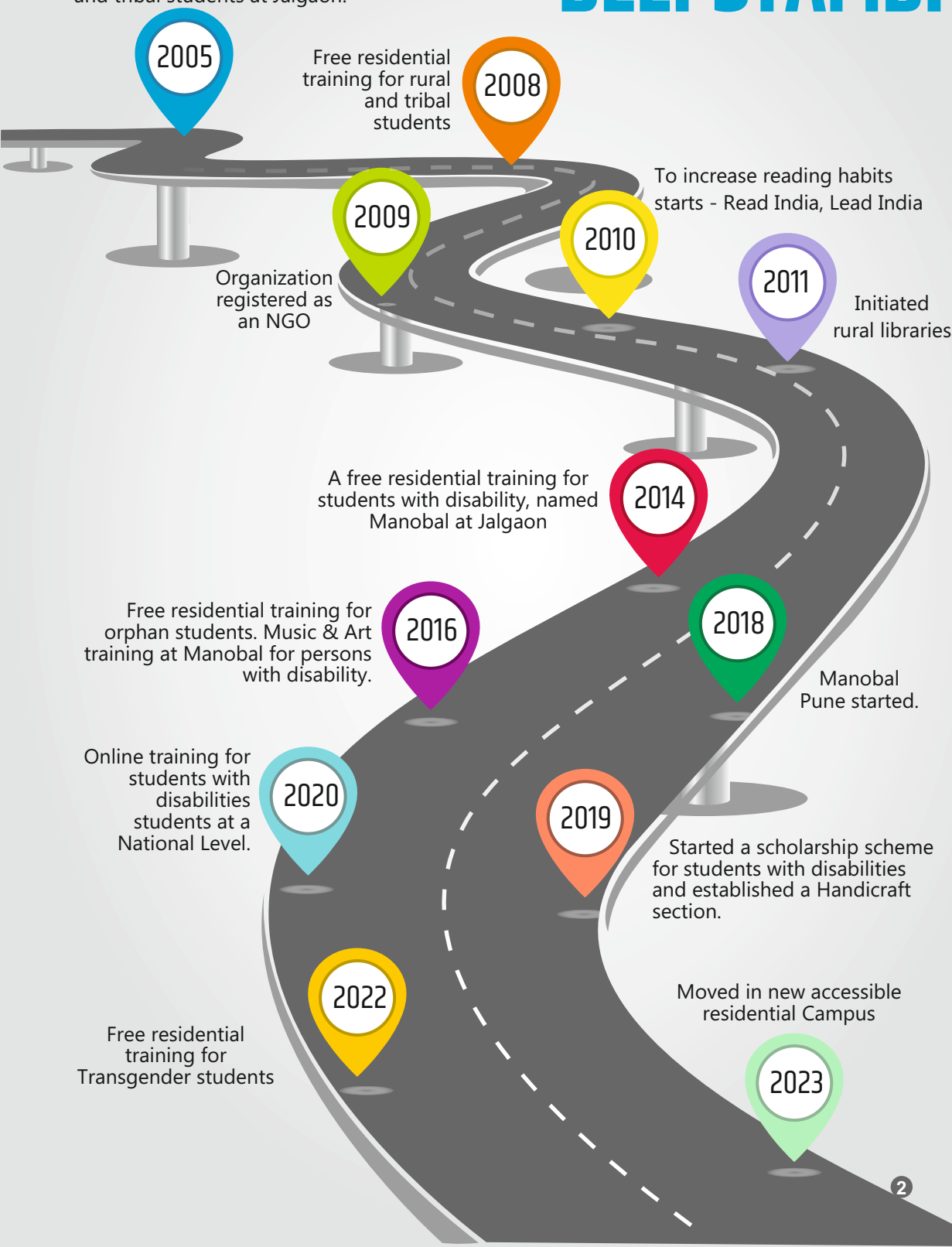

Mobility Training for Visually Impaired Students Officers

With 25 years of experience in training visually impaired individuals he taught the students precise techniques of using white canes, effective utilization of other sensory abilities and tactile perception to identify objects.

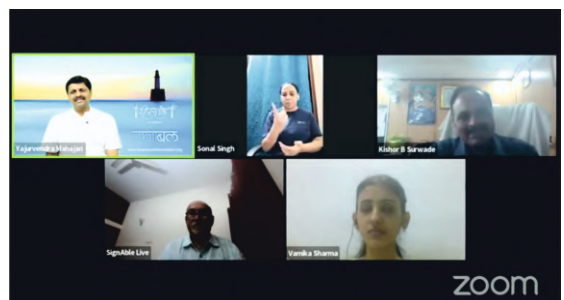
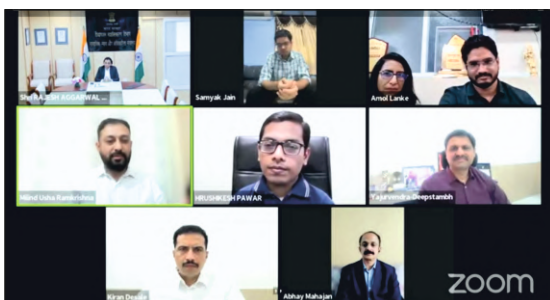
Breaking Barriers: Abhyas Mitra for Visually Impaired !

As far as I know, no transgender person has been accepted in competitive examinations before.

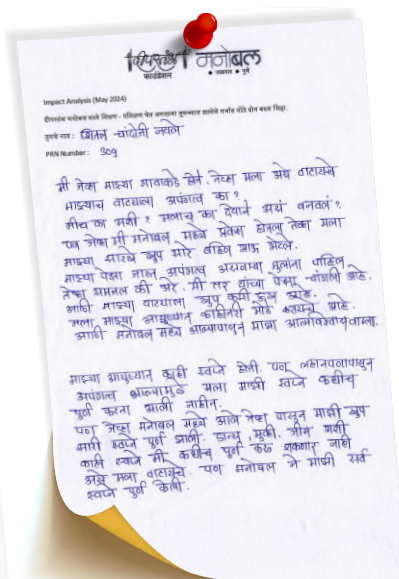

Impact Analysis

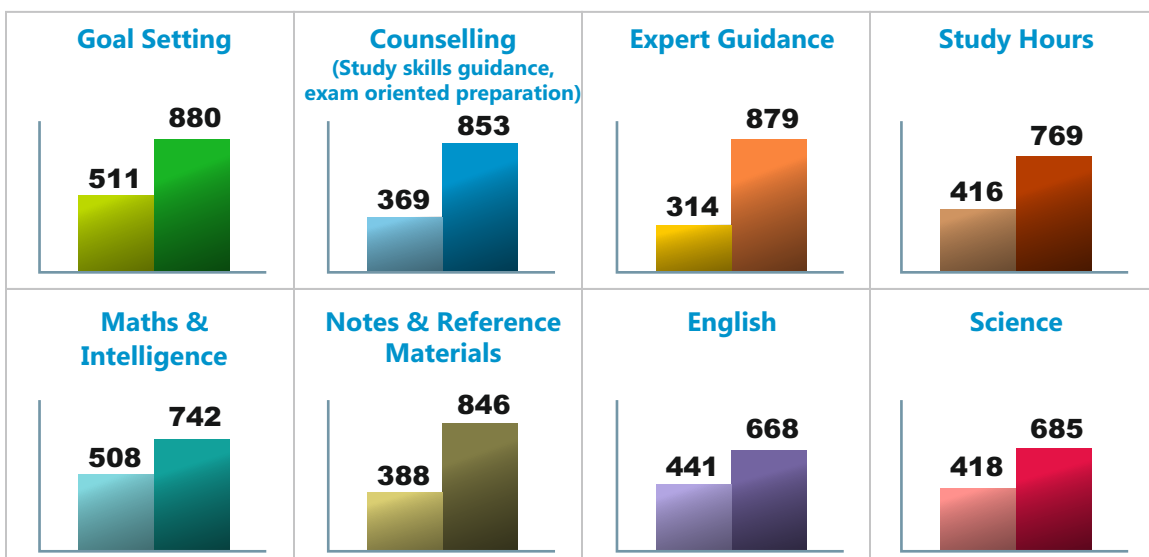

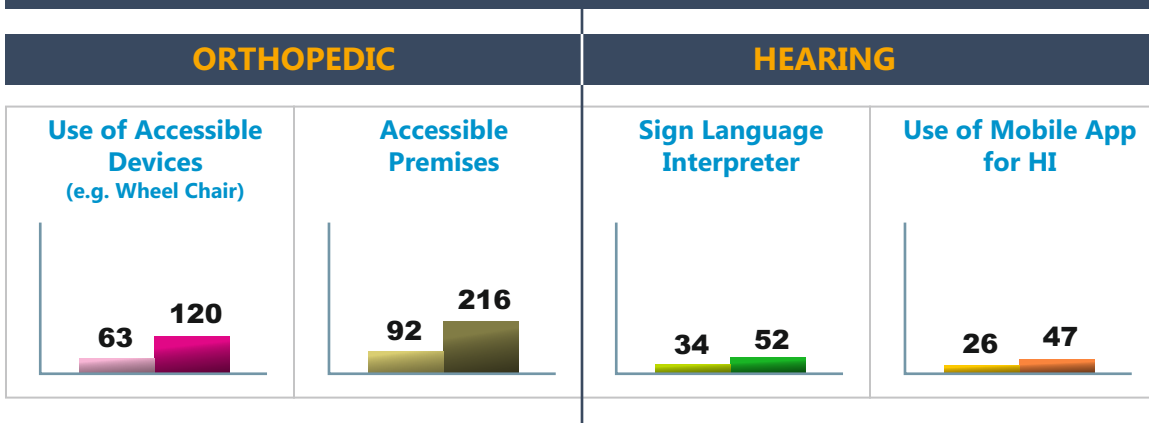

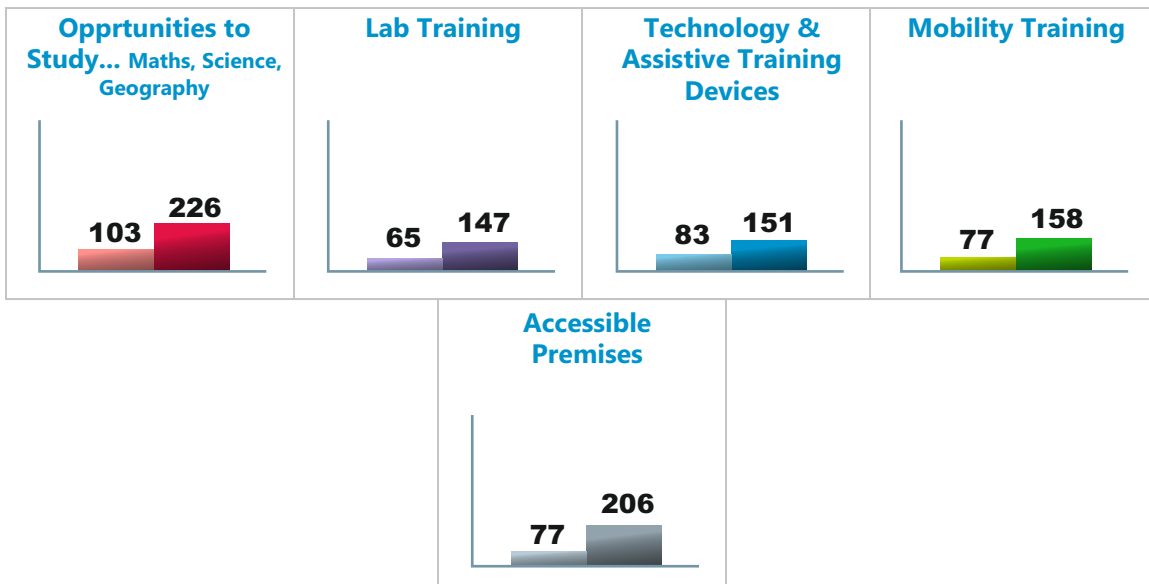


DEVELOPMENT OF IMPAIRED STUDENTS

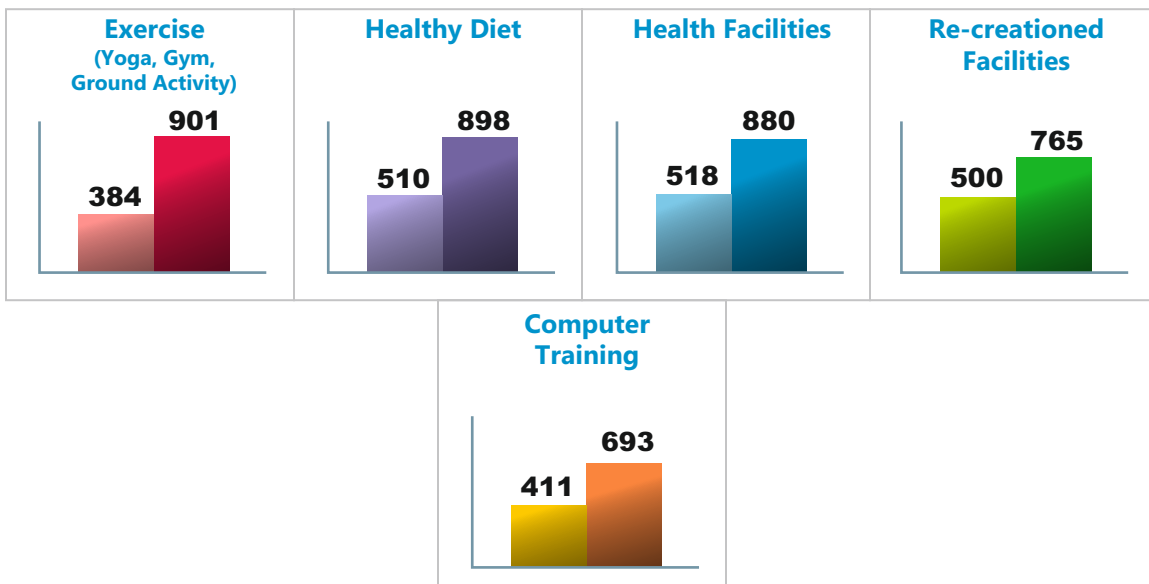
