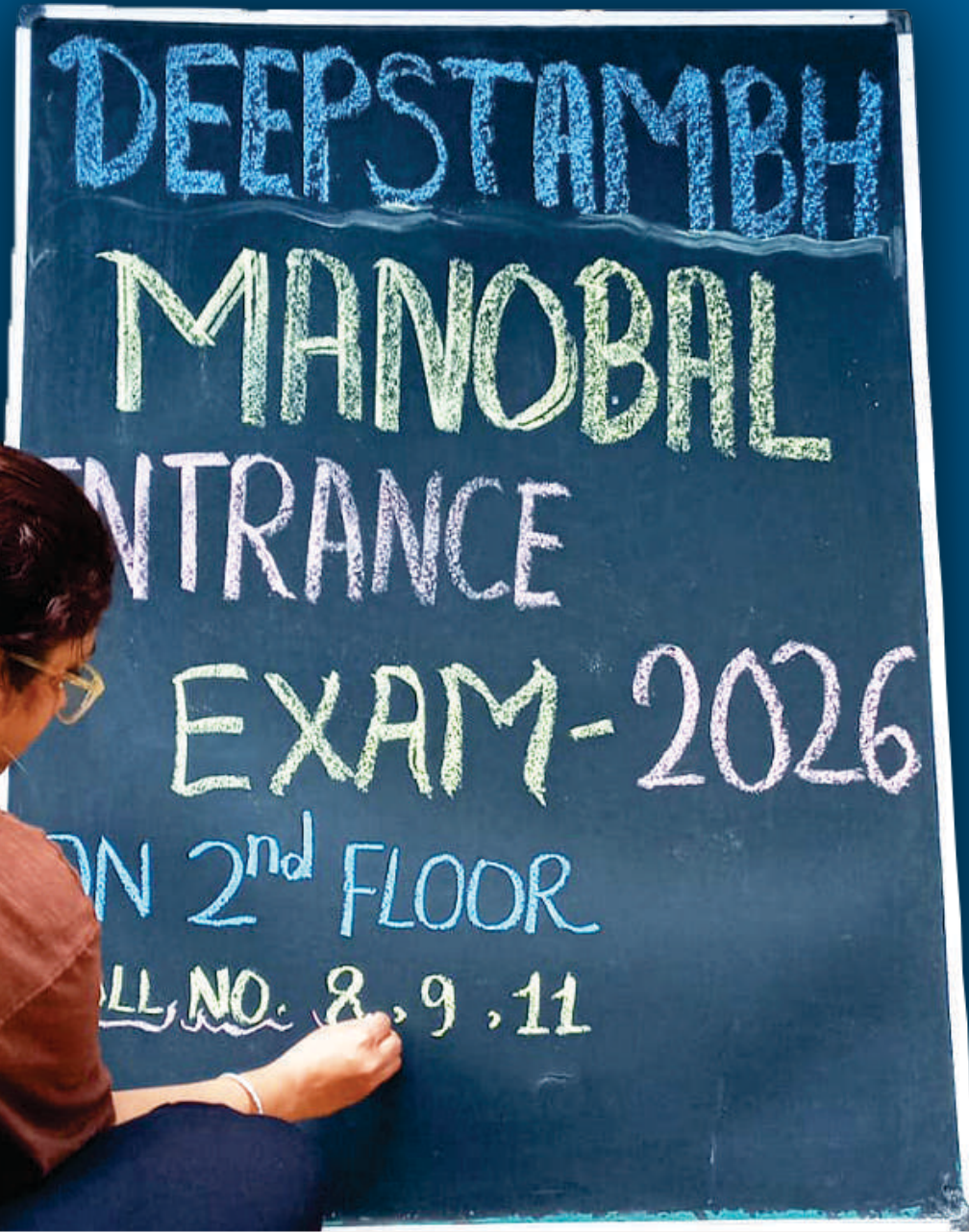

*Deepstambh Foundation organised Success Lab 2026, a five-day residential summer camp for students from Classes 8 to 12, from 27 to 31 May 2026 at **Aryan Eco Resort, Jalgaon.***

*Guided by Shri. Yajurvendra Mahajan and mentors from across India — Mr. Ketan Gawand, Mr. Pravin Gambhir, Mr. Tushar Chothani, Ms. Roshni Radhakrishnan and Dr. Archana Gupta — students explored self-discovery, life skills, career choices, emotional intelligence, digital discipline, adventure activities and cultural expression. **In keeping with Deepstambh's inclusive vision, 20% seats were reserved for students with disabilities and lower income group backgrounds.***

Basic Course – *From confusion to clarity: goal setting, communication, habits, consistency and self-belief.*

Advanced Course – *From confidence to leadership: public speaking, self-awareness, relationship management and long-term vision.*

The deeper outcome – *Students returned with sharper direction, a stronger inner voice and the courage to dream responsibly.*

Success Lab was graced by **Hon. Rohan Ghuge, Collector, Jalgaon, and Prof. Manish Joshi from KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon**, who shared valuable insights with students.

Deepstambh teams connected with aspirants at UPSC Preliminary Examination centres across Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Jaipur, Ahmedabad, Delhi, Patna, Mumbai, Pune, Jammu, Bhopal, Nagpur, Raipur, Prayagraj, Bhubaneswar, Lucknow, Indore, Jabalpur, Varanasi, Nashik and Srinagar.

Eligible students with disabilities, orphan backgrounds, transgender identities and lower income group backgrounds were encouraged to apply for **free residential guidance**. At Delhi and Gurugram centres, the Prelims Support Drive provided transportation, refreshments and support to students and scribes, resulting in **98 new Divyang UPSC aspirant registrations**.
